

FAQs for Public Performance Rights

A guide to organising educational screenings for any of the acclaimed documentaries in the Film Platform catalogue.

What kind of licence is required for my screening?

The vast majority of educational and community screenings are covered by Public Performance Rights (PPR for short). This licence is necessary for any educational or non-commercial screenings. The price to book a PPR licence for any film title in our catalogue is \$300 USD.

What is the process of booking a licence and receiving the film?

You can book a PPR licence through our website: simply visit the page of the film that you are interested in screening and click "Book a Screening". Select the screening type that is most relevant to your needs and follow the instructions on screen. You'll be given the option to choose how you would like to receive the film: as a high resolution digital file, as a DVD, or as a BluRay (where available.)

Once we have received your payment, we arrange for the film to be sent to you immediately. If you have opted for the digital copy, you will receive an email with a secure link from which you can download a high-resolution file of the film. If you have chosen the disc option, then you will be receiving your DVD or BluRay within 5-10 days. (If you require expedited shipment, then please get in touch and we can arrange this. We are always happy to send a digital file as backup in case you are worried that the disc won't reach you in time.)

Do I need to register the date of my screening?

No. Once you have purchased the PPR licence, you are able hold the screening whenever suits you best!

How long is the licence valid for?

Our PPR licence is offered in perpetuity, allowing you and other members of your institution to hold repeated screenings of the film.

Are there any regulations regarding audience size?

We don't impose any restrictions regarding a maximum number of audience members. Instead, we would encourage you to spread the word to make sure as many people as possible know about your screening and have a chance to watch this important film. What happens if I would like to organise screenings for multiple films?
