6 FEMALE CARTOONIST REDIFINING THE LINES

In today's era of digital misinformation, cartoonists retain their influence as essential voices. They offer a distinctive perspective that cuts through the clutter of social media, populism, and fake news, offering clarity and acting as beacons of social commentary and activism.

DRAW FOR CHANGE! is a
6-part documentary series
featuring female cartoonists
from Mexico, India, Russia,
Syria, Egypt, and the
USA. It delves into their
artistic world, exploring


how their drawings impact real lives. Each episode, directed by a distinguished female director from these respective countries, seamlessly blends documentary, cartoons, and animation.

These cartoonists often have compelling stories; for instance, Amany Al-Ali from Syria, caught between Assad forces and extremist groups, boldly criticizes both sides through her cartoons. Meanwhile, Rachita Taneja faces a potential two-year prison

sentence for her art's alleged contempt of India's Supreme Court.

In this series we'll meet strong women who are each rebellious in their own way: they draw because it is unthinkable for them not to do so. The price they pay for performing their work gives these characters a dramatic edge. They have been fired, intimidated or threatened with death. But they invariably refuse to give in and succeed - if only a little - in changing their society.



EPISODE 1 - BEHIND THE LINES



IN IDLIB, DIRECTORS ALISAR HASAN AND ALAA AMER INTRODUCE US TO AMANY AL-ALI, THE CITY'S PIONEERING FEMALE CARTOONIST. SHE EMPOWERS YOUNG WOMEN AND CHALLENGES PATRIARCHAL SYSTEMS WITH HER ART. AMID PERSONAL EXHAUSTION AND TRAUMA, AMANY FACES THE TOUGH CHOICE OF LEAVING HER CITY AND LOVED ONES BEHIND.



SYNOPSIS

Amany Al-Ali stands out as one of Syria's few female cartoonists, residing in her father's home in Idlib, the last city unconquered by Assad's forces. Like her remaining neighbours she's submitted to relentless Russian airstrikes and caught between advancing troops and extremist groups. Despite acclaim for her art, she faces threats, condemnation, and degradation, causing her to contemplate leaving.

Ironically, her artwork has graced galleries in France and Italy but never received exposure within Syria's borders. The film captures her endeavor to organize her inaugural exhibition in Idlib. This experience compels her to confront the harsh realities of a city defined by bombings and male interference.

While organizing drawing lessons for women and girls, comforting her young niece, and sharing her story with the documentary crew, Amany's outlook on the future gradually erodes.








AMANY AL-ALI

Amany al-Ali is one of the few female cartoonists in Syria. She works and lives in Idlib, the only city that hasn't yet been recaptured by Assad's troops. Russian bombers are constantly carrying out raids on the area and the inhabitants of Idlib are trapped between Assad's advancing troops and Al Nusra, the local branch of Al Qaeda. In this particularly difficult environment, Amanyv continues to draw: critical both for Assad and the religious fundamentalists. In her father's house she organizes drawing lessons for women and girls.

Through drawing, these classes cover a whole range of subjects that are part of their world, including war and international indifference about it, and life as women within a traditional patriarchal order.




SYNOPSIS

Statistics on gender-based violence in Mexico are disconcerting: every day around 10 women are murdered in the country and over the last six years, the number of disappeared women and girls has tripled. According to official data, in 2022 a total of 3,754 women and girls were assassinated – and only 947 of them were investigated as femicides.

In a country where public conversations on matters of security and violence seem too often dominated by drug-related crimes, artists like Mar Maremoto try to break the silence that has for too long minimized the extent of this violence. By sharing her artwork on her Instagram account, she provides a safe space for her audience, and she goes even further.

In the documentary, Mar engages with real victims, delving into the impact of their experiences, their coping mechanisms, and ways of self-defense. Most importantly, the film seeks to unravel the reasons behind the high femicide rate and explore avenues for bringing about change.







MAR MAREMOTO

Mar mar maremoto, or Mariana Lorenzo, is a 24-year-old artist from Mexico City, who defines herself as "feminist and queer". She makes cartoons and illustrations, embroidery, fashion, photography and video's from a feminist perspective that try to deconstruct gender stereotypes. She is part of Feminasty, a feminist collective that is dedicated to promote female and non-binary artists. She also collaborates in Malvestida, a digital platform dedicated to women, publishing vignettes every other Thursday. She has 170.000 followers on instagram and works for Nike as an influencer.

Her illustrations are usually accompanied by text, showing scenes from everyday life with ideas and concerns that most women and queer people have. Her signature colours are pink and red.



VICTORIA LOMASKO, AN ARTIST WHO HAS BEEN DOCUMENTING PUTIN'S RUSSIA FOR A DECADE, EXPLORES THE LINK BETWEEN DOMESTIC AND STATE-SPONSORED VIOLENCE IN THE MIDST OF AN IMPENDING CRISIS. AFTER FLEEING HER COUNTRY IN THE SPRING OF 2022 SHE UNDERTOOK HER MOST AMBITIOUS MURAL PROJECT, DEPICTING THE EVENTS THAT UNFOLDED SINCE THE PROTEST-FILLED WINTER OF 2021.



SYNOPSIS

Over the past decade, the artist Victoria Lomasko has dedicated herself to meticulously chronicling Putin's Russia, immersing herself in the heart of rallies and pivotal political moments. Fueled by a palpable sense of impending catastrophe, just a year before Russia's invasion of Ukraine, she embarks on a profound exploration of the intricate connections between domestic and state-sponsored violence. Crafting a historical narrative that spans from the protest-filled winter of 2021 to the tragic winter of 2022, she distills her discoveries into what would become her most ambitious mural to date.

As Putin launches a 'military operation' in Ukraine, branding Russian dissidents as "traitors, to be spat out like flies", Lomasko confronts the harsh reality that she can no longer continue her work in Russia. With this realization, she makes the courageous decision to leave everything behind and forge a new path.



VICTORIA LOMASKO

Victoria Lomasko (1978) is a Russian graphic artist. She was born in Serpukhov and studied at the Moscow State University of Printing Arts. She graduated in 2003, with a major in graphic art and book design. Her first book, "Forbidden Art", written with Anton Nikolaev, won Russia's prestigious Kandinsky prize. She documents the side of Russian life the authorities would rather no one noticed. After Russia's full invasion in Ukraine. Lomasko fled Russia for Brussels, Belgium. This period coincided with promotion of her latest book, The Last Soviet Artist, in Europe and an exhibit based on it in Brescia. Italy, as part of Brescia's Festival For Peace.




SYNOPSIS

Rachita Taneja, creator of SANITARY PANELS, a popular stick figure cartoon series known for its sharp socio-political commentary, has captivated young, liberal Indians. In December 2020, she faced legal prosecution for three of her cartoons, prompting a need for extreme caution not only in her art but also in her involvement in this documentary. The challenges and uncertainties they encounter during filming strengthen the bond between Rachita and the filmmaker, fostering introspection on their beliefs, privileges, and inner struggles. The wait for the legal outcome adds stress, hindering Rachita's work. She seeks guidance and support from like-minded individuals dedicated to amplifying their voices. The film explores Rachita's inner world and her creative expression, depicting a dystopian narrative where freedom of speech rapidly erodes. This documentary showcases the resilience of a young Indian woman facing persecution and censorship with humor and unflinching honesty.



RACHITA TANEJA



In a remarkable fusion of documentary, cartoons, and animation, Egyptian director Nada Riyadh breathes life into el-Adl's most renowned works. This dynamic and fearless presentation delves into the issue of violence against women, stretching the boundaries of freedom of speech in a society often characterized by restrictions.

Through her exceptional talent, el-Adl not only champions women's rights but also serves as an inspiration for societal change.



DOAA EL-ADL

Doaa El-Adl (1979) is an Egyptian cartoonist currently working for the Al-Masry Al-Youm newspaper, known for her satirical cartoons with strong political, social or religious themes. She has been cited as Egypt's most famous female cartoonist. Her work at Al-Masry Al-Youm has received considerable attention and created controversy. She lives and works in Cairo.





Ann Telnaes is an American editorial cartoonist. She creates editorial cartoons in various media-animation, visual essays, live sketches, and traditional print workfor the Washington Post. She also provides publishing for The Nib. In 2001, Telnaes became the second female cartoonist and one of the few freelancers to win the Pulitzer Prize for Editorial Cartooning. In 2017, she received the Reuben Award, becoming the first woman to receive both the Reuben Award and the Pulitzer Prize for Editorial Cartooning.

Her cartoons tend to be liberal in tone and have a regular focus on women's issues.

VINCENT COEN & GUILLAUME VANDENBERGHE

As we began conceptualising this project in 2018, there were numerous global events that had a significant impact on us.

The #MeToo movement went global, while at the same time a misogynistic populist was president of the United States. Populism and nationalism had driven people to vote for the Brexit and now it became clear that this was a terrible mistake. In Russia and China leaders made sure that they would stay in place for a very long time.

In this world where male autocrats solidified their powers and algorithmic driven populism was reshuffling the cards, who were the people that could make a difference?

Cartoonists play a critical role in our world of social media, populism and fake news, offering a unique perspective and voice that can help to cut through the noise and provide clarity in a sea of information. In this digital age of post-truth, the cartoon did not lose any of its power for social commentary and activism. On the contrary. Why make a series about female cartoonists? Being a woman cartoonist often

means, facing a double threat: she will not only be attacked because of her drawings but also just because she is a woman. At the same time she has double power: she is not only challenging the political establishment, but also male dominated society. As filmmakers this paradox is so fascinating because it creates the possibility for multi-layered, complex and courageous characters. Protagonists that challenge the status quo and injustices of their society and by doing so exposing themselves to conflict and danger.

Those in power have always been aware of the subversive potential of cartoons. In mainstream media, today the art of cartooning is increasingly under pressure. Recently the New York Times decided to stop publishing cartoons, after one of their cartoons featuring Trump and Netanyahu created a huge controversy.

If cartooning disappears, then the free press will follow... And with the free press, out goes democracy. Like Ann Telnaes, cartoonist of the Washington Post puts it: "It's a funny word 'cartoon', but it's serious business."



GUILLAUME VANDENBERGHE

Guillaume Vandenberghe has been working as a filmmaker in Brussels for 20 years. Together with Vincent, he co-directed the documentary features "Cinéma Inch'Allah!" and "Nothing is forgiven". Besides these, he has also made art films that have been shown in museums and art galleries such as the Hamburger Kunsthalle, Maison Rouge (Paris) and Hauser & Wirth (New York).

VINCENT COEN

Vincent Coen is a writer-director living and working between Brussels and Jerusalem. After obtaining a graduate degree in Social and Political sciences at University of Ghent, Vincent studied film directing at RITCS School of Arts. He made two documentary features "Cinéma Inch'Allah!" and "Nothing is forgiven". His fiction short "Heartbeats" premiered at Tribeca Film Festival and won several awards. Vincent has also written for television and works as a script editor on fiction scripts.

TEAM - DIRECTORS



ALISAR HASAN (SYRIA)

Alisar Hasan is a director and writer, born in Syria in 1983 and currently based in Berlin. In 2014, she founded Radio Sout Raya in Turkey, a radio station for Syrian refugees. She produced and directed for Radio Sout Raya until ISIS cyber-attacks forced its closure in 2017. For her work on the Oscarnominated documentary THE CAVE, she won the IDA Best Writing Award and was a Creative Emmy nominee for Outstanding Writing. BEHIND THE LINES, co-directed with Alaa Amer, is her first feature film.



ALAA AMER (SYRIA)

Alaa Amer is a director and journalist born in Syria in 1983, currently based in Istanbul. She is a founding member of the Syrian Feminist Lobby and has published several investigative articles on violations against women and human rights. She has produced and directed many investigative TV shows and wrote the script for the short film GOAL TO SYRIA, which was selected at Cannes in 2014. BEHIND THE LINES, co-directed with Alisar Hasan, is her first feature film.




KAREN VÁZQUEZ GUADARRAMA (MEXICO)

Karen Vázquez Guadarrama was born in Mexico City and studied film at the Royal Academy of Fine Arts in Ghent, Belgium. Her short film Mont d'Or, her short documentary FLOR DE MIL COLORES and her feature film WHEN THE BULL CRIED were selected at various important international film festivals. Karen won the prestigious Camerimage 2018 for her work as a DOP. Besides directing the film WE ARE FIRE about Mexican cartoonist Maremoto, she was also the DOP for the Egyptian episode about Doaa El-Adl.



ANNA MOISEENKO (RUSSIA)

Anna Moiseenko is an award-winning filmmaker from Russia, currently based between France and Belgium. Her first documentary WINTER, GO AWAY! (2012) premiered at Locarno and received a number of prestigious awards, a.o. the Russian film critics award "Discovery of the Year," Best Film (Textura Festival) and Best Debut (Lisbon & Estoril Film Festival). Her films S.P.A.R.T.A. (2013) and SONGS OF ABDUL (2017) were also well-received at international festivals and achieved wide theatrical release.



SAMA PANA (INDIA)

Sama Pana is a pseudo for an independent documentary filmmaker and producer from India. She studied documentary film making abroad before returning to her homeland to pursue her passion for character-driven documentaries with a political context. One of Sama's previous films was widely praised for its sensitive and empathetic portrayal of marginalised communities in India.

NADA RIYADH (EGYPT)

Nada Riyadh is a film director/producer based in Cairo, Egypt. Her debut documentary film HAPPILY EVER AFTER premiered at IDFA in 2016. Her short fiction FAKH (The Trap) was selected for Semaine de la Critique at Cannes. In 2016, Nada co-founded the Cairo-based production company Felucca Films, aiming to help filmmakers from the MENA region explore and shape their own personal voices. She is now in post-production of her second feature documentary, LAND OF WOMEN, co-directed with Ayman El Amir.



LAURA NIX (USA)

Laura Nix is an award-winning director, writer and producer based in LA. Her short WALK RUN CHA-CHA was nominated for a Best Short Documentary Oscar in 2020. Other critically acclaimed titles include: INVENTING TOMORROW (premiered at Sundance 2018, was broadcast on PBS and won several awards including the Peabody Award in 2020), THE YES MEN ARE REVOLTING (Toronto Film Festival 2014, Berlinale 2015), THE LIGHT IN HER EYES (premiered at IDFA 2011 and was broadcast on POV and Al Jazeera).

HANNE PHLYPO CLIN D'OEIL FILMS

Hanne Phlypo is a Belgian producer. Her latest productions **DRAW FOR CHANGE** (2023), **DREAMING WALLS: INSIDE THE CHELSEA HOTEL** (2022) and **BY THE NAME OF TANIA** (2019) premiered at leading festivals and won multiple awards worldwide. Hanne trained as director at the Belgian film school INSAS. In 2010 she founded Clin d'oeil films and has since then produced over 30 films.

The company focuses on creative documentaries and author-driven film with a clear preference for films with a social or political statement by innovative filmmakers. Today, Clin d'oeil films is one of Belgian's most prominent documentary production companies, famous for cinematic films and local stories with a global impact. Hanne is an alumna of EAVE, Eurodoc and a member of the European Film Academy.



ESTELLE ROBIN YOU GRANDE OURSE FILMS

Estelle Robin You is CEO and producer at GRANDE OURSE films. a company she founded in February 2023 in Nantes (France). Between 2005 and 2022 within Les films du balibari, Estelle produced more than thirty documentaries that travelled to festivals and were broadcasted on television channels throughout the world. VILLAGE WITHOUT WOMEN (ARTE/ZDF), THE LAST SHELTER (DOX:AWARD 21), A THOUSAND FIRES (Locarno's Marco Zucchi award) are among the films she has produced and were selected at festivals such as IDFA, VISIONS DU REEL, HOT DOCS.

Estelle is a graduate of the Ex Oriente and EAVE Producers Workshop. She is a group leader at EAVE CHANGE and Eurodoc and a member of the European Film Academy.



MARION GUTH A_BAHN

Marion Guth cofounded a BAHN in 2011. a_BAHN produced a.o. the highlyacclaimed **ZERO IMPUNITY** by Blies Brothers (2019, Annecy, Sao Paulo IFF, Moscow IFF, Thessaloniki IFF, Amiens IFF, Guadalajara IFF...), Blies Brothers' transmédia **SOUNDHUNTERS** (ARTE -2016, nominated for the Prix Europa), VR films like 7 LIVES (2019, Tribeca Film Festival) and cosmos within us (2019, Mostra di Venezia), or more recently ARTE's documentary MONK, PANNONICA, AN AMERICAN STORY and the immersive experience SEX, DESIRE AND DATA. Marion recently created an association for better representation on screen and inclusiveness in the audiovisual sector: Fraen Am Bild - Women in Motion. With the association WIDE (Women in Digital Empowerment), she is a consultant in training for women artists around digital art and web3/NFTs practices. In partnership with the Ministry of Equality between Women and Men (MEGA), she develops an observatory of diversity in the film industry.



HEINO DECKERT MA.JA.DE. FILMPRODUKTION

Heino Deckert founded Ma.ja.de. Filmproduktions GmbH in 1991. For 30 years now, the German filmproduction company ma.ja.de. has consistently delivered documentaries and feature films selected at international festivals and securing worldwide distribution. Heino has produced over 130 films to date with filmmakers like Sergei Loznitsa, Victor Kossakovsky, Ai Weiwei, Thomas Heise and Feras Fayyad. Heino is a member of the German and European Film Academy and a member of Ampas.



SIGRID DYEKJAER REAL LAVA

Sigrid Dyekjaer has produced more than 30 documentary films during the last 22 years. She is the producer of the Oscar nominated film **THE CAVE** (2020) by Feras Fayyad, for which she won an Emmy for best producer, a Peabody Award, best producer at Cinema Eye and was nominated for Producers Guild of America in 2020. She premiered her first documentary film in her new company Real Lava at Sundance 2022, **THE TERRITORY** by Alex Pritz, which won 2 Awards at Sundance and has just picked up its 24th award already this year.
